“International students’ and researchers’ entry in the EU and in Italy in particular: incoming issues and relevant regulations”

The objective of the seminar is sharing good practices on issues as incoming and administrative procedures for the entry and stay of students and researchers coming from European, Third and Associated Countries.

Contents: the European Commission has registered that, notwithstanding a specific Directive making it mandatory for States to facilitate the admission of non-EU students and researchers to European mobility programmes, lengthy procedures to obtain visas to enter EU countries worryingly prevents interested subjects from participation in some cases. Not only will relevant legislation and some specific cases be analyzed (e.g. how to apply for family reunion or for the issuing/renewal of a permit of stay), but also, in more general terms, the whole range of rights and duties of people coming from EU countries, countries belonging to the Schengen area, the so-called associated countries and non-EU countries.
